James Nancarrow

????: Born.

????: Married ????

James was a tinner.

1847: Son born – James Nancarrow. (See below)

1882 or later: James Nancarrow died.

James Nancarrow

1847: Born.

1882: Married Sarah Trelease 14th December 1882 at Redruth Registry Office (born 1857 at Gwennap)

1884 circa: Son born – Thomas James Nancarrow.

1888 circa: Son born – Hedley Nancarrow.

1888 or later: Moved to Grove Cottage, Frogpool, Gwennap.

1888: James was a tinner/lead miner working abroad mainly.

1888: Daughter born – Rhoda Nancarrow. (See below)

1891: Living at Cusgarne Common but they may not have moved, this may simply be the name for the area.

1901: Sarah, aged 42, was living at Chacewater with her brothers, Thomas and William Trelease, her daughter, Rhoda Nancarrow, and her son, Hedley Nancarrow.

In later life Sarah lived in Newquay.

????: James died.

1941: Sarah died and was buried 10th November 1941 at Gwennap Parish Church.

Rhoda Nancarrow

1888: Born 23rd August 1888 at Perranwell, Perranzabuloe.

1888: Christened 26th November 1888 at Perranporth.

1888: Living in Perranporth.

We know little of the young Rhoda but at the time of her marriage she was living at 78 Hampton Place, Newquay.

1911: Married Alfred Scott Mansell 22nd October 1911 at Claremont Church, Newquay. (See Mansell Family Story)
